#### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Entry forms must accompany the entry.
- 2. Entries will be accepted at the exhibition venue from 10am 2pm on Thursday 29th October 2020, unless previously arranged with Pomona & District Community House (PCH).
- 3. The judges reserve the right to not award all prizes where insufficient items are entered.
- 4. Items must be of a safe, manageable weight and size (can be on wheels or trolley).
- 5. Challenge #3: photo of original garment required.
- 6. The judges' decision is final.
- 7. All items are to be collected (with presentation of entry receipt or proof of identity) from the exhibition venue between 11am 2pm Thursday 26th November 2020, unless previously arranged with PCH.
- 8. Any entries not collected by Thursday 26th November 2020 without prior arrangement will be discarded.
- 9. All entries must be the work of the entrant (individual or collaboration) and completed in the last two years.
- 10. The event officials will exercise all reasonable care with work.
- 11. Exhibits will not be insured at the expense of the PCH or Pomona Railway Station Gallery
- 12. Any sales of exhibits at Pomona Railway Station Gallery will incur a 30% commision.
- 13. Entrants will allow their work to be on public display and for video and photographs of said work be used as promotional material on our Facebook page, websites and in print.
